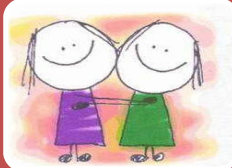


A Time Auction is an auction of quality products and services, except instead of bidding with money, people bid with volunteering hours. For example, you might bid 30 hours at the local animal shelter in order to get a digital camera.

The inaugural Time Auction was held in Kingston, Ontario and garnered 705 volunteering hours for 14 different charities – nationally and locally. This year in Vancouver, we hope to pass the 1000-hour mark.

- Req: \$100 total value of products and services



Millennium Partner

- Century Collaborator + higher starting bid + bigger displays
- Official event sponsor; logo displayed on all materials, slides
- Req: \$1000 total value of products and services
